






How to reduce emissions?

Buildings matter



Experience with EDF Climate Corps:

- Served as an EDF Climate Corps fellow at adidas in 2010;
 joined the company full-time in June 2011
- Hired two EDF Climate Corps fellows in 2011 to work in four facilities
- Results: \$1.6 million in savings in Indianapolis and Montreal;
 25% and 20% energy reduction in Portland and Carlsbad.

EDF CLIMATE CORPS



Company Requirements:

- Pay fellow \$1,250/week for 10-12 weeks, plus travel
- High-level sponsor and day-to-day supervisor
- Access to relevant data
- Implement fellows' recommendations where feasible
- Report progress to EDF.
